DAY 1: DEPARTURE / USA TO ROME

Your culinary experience today by boarding your flight to Rome. Meals and drinks will be served on board.

DAY 2: ROME/SULMONA

After arriving at Rome Fiumicino airport, our private coach will take us to our hotel in Sulmona. Dinner and overnight accommodations will be available after check-in.

DAY 3: SULMONA/ATRI/SULMONA

We begin our day with a guided tour of Atri. This beautiful village is famous for its wonderful Renaissance frescoes and licorice. We will visit a family-owned shop, where we'll discover and taste some excellent local licorice-based products. After lunch, we will visit the Nettore Bosco winery to sample some of the region's wonderful wines, like Montepulciano D'Abruzzo and Pecorino D'Abruzzo. Later at dinner, we will sample traditional regional cuisines such as Arrosticini, seasoned goat or lamb, roasted over an open grill and served family style. Overnight accommodations will be at your hotel.

DAY 4: SULMONA/ORTONA/TRABOCCHI COAST/SULMONA

We begin today with a guided tour of Ortona, focusing on the 1943 Battle of Ortona. This city, also known for its Cathedral, is the seat of the Regional Winehouse. Afterward, we will have a short lesson from a sommelier who'll teach you some of the secrets of Abruzzo's wine. After lunch, we will travel to the Trabocchi Coast, known for its incredible Aleppo pine fishing machines called Trabuccos, which are protected as historical monuments in parts. Finally, we return to our hotel in Sulmona to retire for the evening.

DAY 5: SULMONA/LANCIANO/VASTO/SULMONA

This morning begins with a guided tour of Lanciano that will include the Diocletian Bridge, The Church of the Eucharistic Miracle (the oldest Eucharistic Miracle recognized by the Catholic Church), and Lancianovecchia (its oldest district). Our tour continues in Vasto, where we will have "brodetto" for lunch. It is a type of fish stew that is a signature dish of almost all Italian Adriatic coastal cities. This afternoon, we will take a guided tour of Vasto and its most significant monument, including a walk along the famous "Loggia Ambling." Later, we return to our hotel in Sulmona for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 6: SULMONA/GUARDIAGRELE/ PENNAPIEDIMONTE/ROCCASCALEGNA/ SULMONA

After breakfast is a guided tour of Guardiagrele. Nicknamed "la Terrazza d'Abruzzo" (Abruzzo's terrace), it is the seat of the Maiella National Park. First, we will sample some "Sise Delle Monache," a dessert specialty in Guardiagrele, followed by a picnic lunch in Pennapiedimonte. This afternoon, we



will take a guided tour of Pennapiedimonte, a small village surrounded by incredible nature that will leave you breathless. Next, we continue to Roccascalegna for a brief tour before returning to our hotel in Sulmona for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 7: SULMONA/CHIETI/BUCCHIANICO/SULMONA

After breakfast, we begin with a guided tour of Chieti to visit the Archeological National Museum, which sits atop a hill just outside the city walls. From the top of the hill, you will have a breathtaking view of the majestic Majella Massif (The Mother of Mountains, one of the most revered mountains in Italy. After lunch, we will visit the Museo dell 'Olio di Cantinarte in Bucchianico for an olive oil tasting. Afterward, we will return to our hotel in Sulmona for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 8: SULMONA

We start today's activities with a morning visit to a factory producing the famous "Sulmona confetti" (sugared almonds). After lunch, we will visit a farm to learn about the region's cheese. Finally, we'll stop at a pasta shop for some local products before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations in Sulmona.

DAY 9: SULMONA/NAVELLI/SANTO STEFANO DI SESSANIO/SULMONA

We start this morning by visiting a saffron farm in Navelli to learn about this spice and all of its wonderful uses. After lunch, we take a guided tour of Santo Stefano di Sessanio, a picturesque mountain village that sat largely abandoned until recent years. Once in ruins, many of the village's buildings have been restored to vacation homes. Being just 96 miles from Rome, it has become a popular weekend and summer retreat for many. Later, we'll return to our hotel in Sulmona for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 10: SULMONA/SCANNO/SULMONA

Today's adventure takes us to a donkey farm. If you aren't familiar with some of the products made from donkey milk, you will be. It's sure to be an exciting adventure. We'll have lunch on the farm, followed by a guided tour of Scanno, one of the most photographed villages in Italy. Later, we'll return to our hotel in Sulmona for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 11: SULMONA/L'AQUILA/ROME

After breakfast, we take a guided tour of L'Aquila, the capital of Abruzzo. Afterward, we'll travel to Rome and participate in a family cooking class. Dinner and overnight accommodations at our hotel in Rome.

DAY 12: DEPARTURE

We will transfer to the airport this morning to board your return flight home. Arrivederci!
